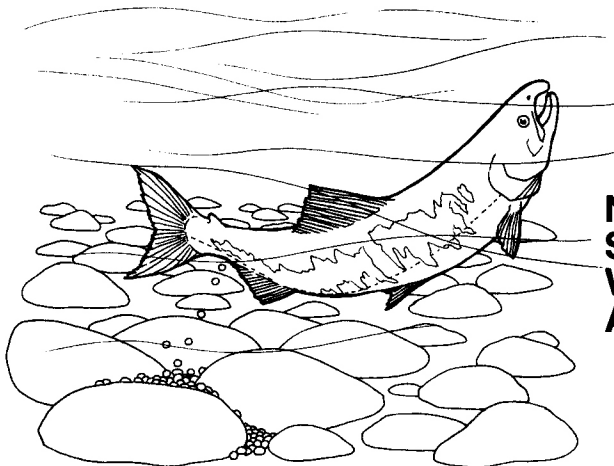
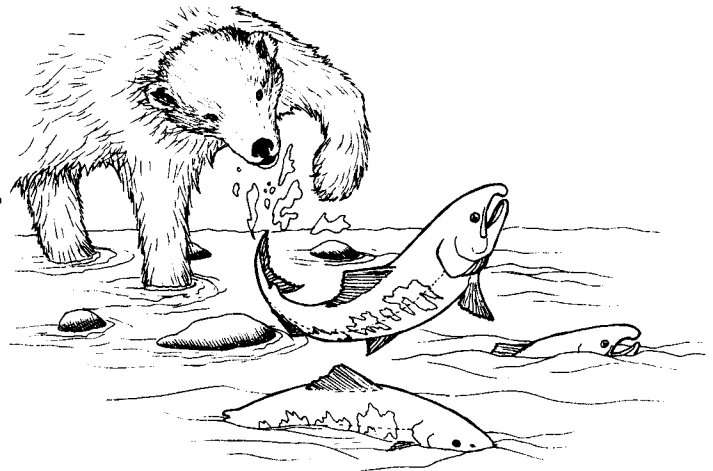
(A Poem)
